Golden Globe Transport, Inc. has been a certified, voluntary participant in the Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism, or C-TPAT, since October 2003. We are wholly committed to adhering to C-TPAT security and the goals of securing the supply chain and curtailing security problems in advance.

An essential aspect of Golden Globe's C-TPAT membership is to ensure that our business and supply chain partners are either C-TPAT certified or committed to upholding the security principles of C-TPAT. If you are currently a member of C-TPAT, please immediately provide us with your C-TPAT certification number.

For our partners that are not enrolled as C-TPAT members, we strongly encourage you to contact US Customs and Border Protection to join now. Not only will you have the benefits of achieving faster clearances and fewer exams, but you will also have the assurance of knowing that your company is being pro-active in ensuring supply chain security. Until you join Golden Globe Transport as a C-TPAT member, we ask that your company adheres to the C-TPAT minimum security guidelines to ensure a secure supply chain for us all. These C-TPAT security guidelines emphasize the need for having strong security requirements in place when choosing your overseas partners, at your supplier's facilities and at the point of cargo loading into a container or truck. All containers and trucks should undergo a 7-point or 17-point inspection prior to loading and they must be sealed with PAS ISO 17712 high security seals. All containers and trucks should again be examined when received at destination submitting to the same 7-point or 17-point inspections and PAS ISO 17712 seal verification. Some of the things to look for are false walls and floors, overages, shortages or incorrect freight in the container, signs of tampering and verifying that the seal numbers match with the numbers provided by the shipper. If you detect any tampering, errors and/or shortages and overages of merchandise that create or can create a security risk in the supply chain it is your obligation to notify the Department of Homeland Security/CBP at **(800)-BE ALERT (800-232-5378)** and any other appropriate law enforcement agencies.

If you feel that you need additional help in making your company C-TPAT certified, Golden Globe Transport will be happy to assist with any guidance or instructions.
